Organization-wide Nominations

Most Creative Program

The Triangle Air Awareness Coalition encourages creativity in order to keep the program fresh and inspire others. Not every option fits every organization or individual. This category award is given to the group that is comprised of people that implemented an idea “outside the box”. At the discretion of the judges, one award per size category may be awarded.

Best Overall Program – Public Sector/ Private Sector

Organizations beyond those nominated for this or other category in the Best of Triangle Air Awareness may be considered to receive this award. In this category, one award winner is selected for all the public sector and one for private sector organizations. It is not done on the basis of size.

Best Outreach To School Children

Environmental Education is an important part of the Triangle Air Awareness program as well as the other programs statewide. Did your organization provide a program or support to a program that educates school children about air quality, their impact, and/or what they can do to improve it? At the discretion of the judges, one award per size category may be awarded.

Individual within an Organization Categories

Best Use of Commute Alternatives By a Commuter

Is there someone within your organization who takes the bus, vanpools, carpools, rides the bike or walks to your organization? Is there something special about their attitude regarding this commute alternative? Do they provide a good example for others? Do they encourage others to try commute alternatives? Is there something about this individual’s use of commute options that deserves recognition? The answers to these questions should help you formulate your entry. Let us know all about it. At the discretion of the judges, one award per size category may be awarded.

Best Transportation/Air Awareness Site Coordinator

Here at Air Awareness we really like Transportation/Air Awareness Coordinators! They are those special people who volunteer to or who are volunteered to (and don’t change companies to avoid it) inform people within their companies about commute alternatives and/or air quality. They work to encourage and motivate us to do our part. Is your transportation coordinator worthy of special notice? Tell us! At the discretion of the judges, one award per size category may be awarded.
