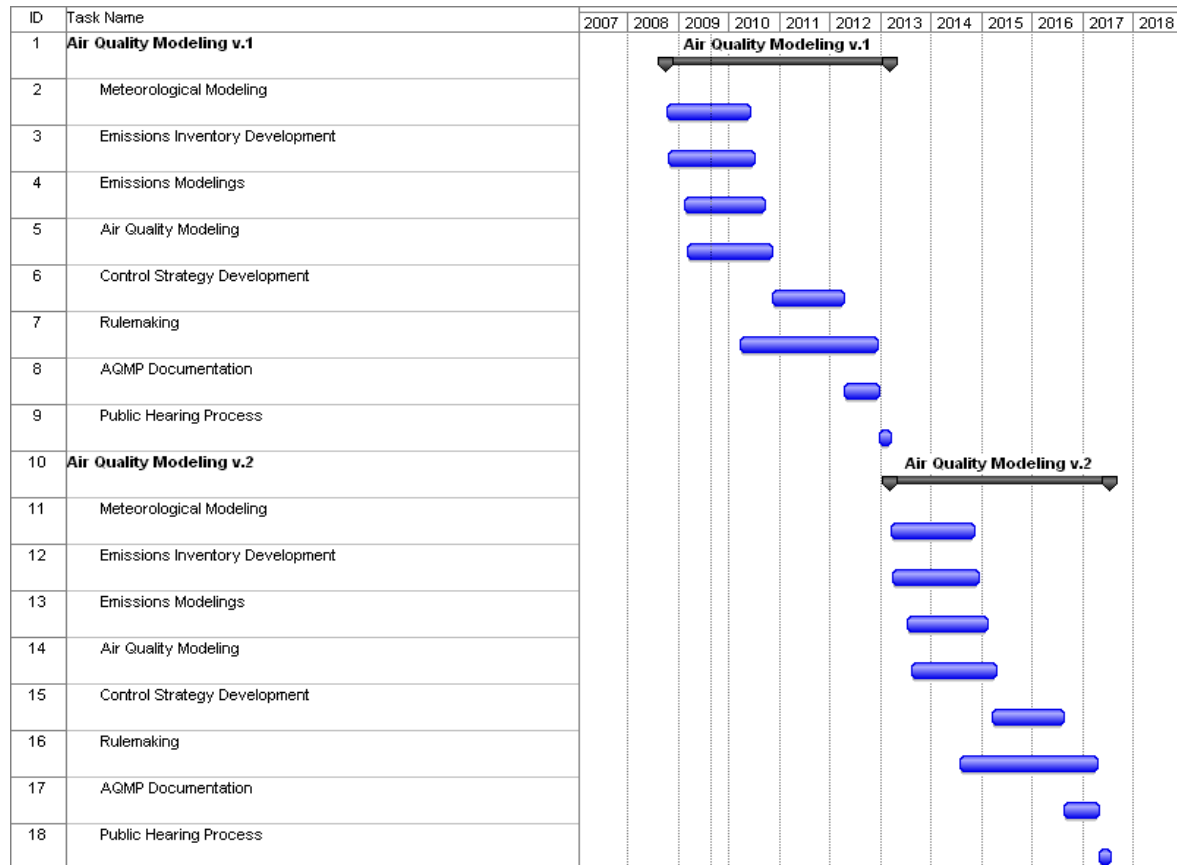

- Routine updates to account for latest scientific developments

Implementation of AQMP

- Challenges include:
 - Ongoing SIP Requirements Interfere with Full Attention Directed to AQMP Development
 - Meeting Statutory Requirements while Developing AQMP
 - EPA's Requirement that SIPs Must Meet Latest Guidance
 - Balancing Dis-benefits of Strategies
 - Others?
