

1 15A NCAC 02Q .0902 is proposed for amendment as follows:

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3 **15A NCAC 02Q .0902 PORTABLE TEMPORARY CRUSHERS**

4 (a) For the purposes of this Rule, "temporary crusher" means a crusher that will not be operated at any
5 one facility or site for more than 12 months.

6 ~~(a)(b)~~ This rule applies to ~~portable crushers~~ any temporary crusher that:

7 (1) ~~crush~~ crushes no more than 300,000 tons at any one facility or site; ~~tons during any 12~~
8 ~~months;~~

9 (2) ~~burn~~ burns no more than 17,000 gallons of diesel fuel at any one facility or site ~~during any~~
10 ~~12 months~~ if it uses:

11 (A) a diesel-fired generator, or

12 (B) a diesel engine to drive the crusher;

13 ~~(3) — do not operate at any one facility or site more than 12 months;~~

14 ~~(4)(3) do~~ does not operate at a quarry that has an air permit issued under this Subchapter; and

15 ~~(5)(4) continuously use~~ uses water spray to control emissions from the ~~crushers.~~ crusher; and

16 (5) does not operate at a facility that is required to have a mining permit issued by the
17 Division of Land Resources.

18 ~~(b)(c)~~ The owner or operator of a ~~portable~~ temporary crusher and any associated generators shall
19 comply with ~~15A NCAC 2D~~ Rules of Subchapter 02D .0510 (Particulates From Sand, Gravel, Or Crushed
20 Stone Operations), .0516 (Sulfur Dioxide Emissions From Combustion Sources), .0521 (Control Of Visible
21 Emissions), .0524 (New Source Performance Standards, 40 CFR Part 60, ~~Subpart Subparts 000), 000~~
22 and IIII), .0535 (Excess Emissions Reporting And Malfunctions), .0540 (Particulates From Fugitive Non-
23 Process Dust), and .1806 (control and prohibition of odorous emissions).

24 ~~(e)(d)~~ The owner or operator of a ~~portable~~ temporary crusher shall not cause or allow any material to be
25 produced, handled, transported, or stockpiled without taking measures to reduce to a minimum any
26 particulate matter from becoming airborne to ~~prevent exceeding~~ ensure that the ambient air quality
27 standards ~~beyond the property line~~ for particulate matter (PM2.5, PM10, and total suspended particulate)
28 are not exceeded beyond the property line. ~~particulates).~~

29 ~~(d)(e)~~ The owner or operator of a ~~portable~~ temporary crusher shall maintain records of the amount of
30 material crushed and the quantity of fuel burned in the diesel-fired generator or engine so that the
31 Division can determine upon review of these records that the crusher qualifies to be covered under this
32 Rule.

33 ~~(e)(f)~~ The owner or operator of a ~~portable~~ temporary crusher shall clearly label each crusher, hopper,
34 feeder, screen, conveyor, elevator, and generator with a permanent and unique identification number.

1 ~~(f)~~(g) If a source is covered under 15A NCAC 2D .0524 (40 CFR Part 60, Subpart OOO), the owner or
2 operator of a ~~portable~~ temporary crusher shall submit to the Director notifications ~~are~~ required under 15A
3 NCAC 2D .0524 (40 CFR Part 60, Subpart OOO).

4 ~~(g)~~(h) If the Director or his authorized representative requests copies of notifications or testing records
5 required under 15A NCAC 2D .0524 (40 CFR Part 60, Subpart OOO), the owner or operator of a ~~portable~~
6 temporary crusher shall submit the requested notifications or testing records within two business days of
7 such a request.

8 (i) If a source is covered under 15A NCAC 2D .0524 (40 CFR Part 60, Subpart IIII), the owner or operator
9 of a compression ignition internal combustion engine (CI ICE) for a temporary crusher shall submit to the
10 Director notifications required under 15A NCAC 2D .0524 (40 CFR Part 60, Subpart IIII).

11 (j) If the Director or his authorized representative requests copies of notifications or testing records
12 required under 15A NCAC 2D .0524 (40 CFR Part 60, Subpart IIII), the owner or operator of a
13 compression ignition internal combustion engine (CI ICE) for temporary crusher shall submit the
14 requested notifications or testing records within two business days of such a request.

15 (k) If the owner or operator of a crusher plans or has the design potential to operate a crusher at a facility
16 or site for more than twelve months, he shall apply for and shall have received an air quality permit issued
17 under this Subchapter before beginning operations.
