

NC Toxics Rule Compliance Procedures:

New Facility:

Compliance with the existing AALs upon startup

Modified Facility:

Compliance with the toxics rules must occur before the operation of the modified equipment.

The facility reevaluates any changed AAL the next time there is a modification that affects only that specific pollutant.

The modification results in a revised air permit.

SIC Call:

Compliance deadline is 3 years from date permit is issued

Director's Call:

No specified compliance time line.

MACT Affected Facility:

Compliance deadline occurs with AALs by same deadline as last MACT (excluding boiler MACT).

Modifications can be made without an air toxics evaluation until permit renewal date (5 year cycle).

The facility reevaluates any changed AAL.

A new air permit is issued with a 5 year life.
